

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MUSICACTION

Fondation Musicaction is a non-profit organization founded in 1985 by private broadcasters and music industry professionals. Its main objective: contributing to the development of local francophone music by offering financial support to projects undertaken by independent record labels and Canadian artists. From production, sound recording and collective initiatives on international markets, to supporting album marketing, live performances and the promotion of artists from minority francophone communities, Musicaction provides the recording industry community with a wide array of tools designed to stimulate the growth and exposure of original French Canadian music.

To this end, Musicaction, through contribution agreements with Canadian Heritage, manages the francophone portion of two Canada Music Fund programs, New Musical Works and Collective Initiatives. Contributions from private radio broadcasters reinforce Musicaction's involvement with the two programs. Since 2002, the Foundation has also been managing Fonds RadioStar, which aims at promoting and marketing local francophone music. Fonds RadioStar is 100% funded by private radio broadcasters.

CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

Thirty years young and looking resolutely to the future. On March 31, the Musicaction Foundation signed its 31st fiscal year, a first under the new contribution agreement with Canadian Heritage, which last year renewed its support for the organization until 2020. The year 2015-2016 was marked by celebrations of the Foundation's 30th anniversary, a unique occasion to reaffirm the organization's commitment to local entrepreneurs and artists who contribute to the development of French Canadian music.

So with renewed communication tools, our identity is even stronger in this anniversary year and is now expressed in a logo summarizing our intervention philosophy: **Concerter – Accompagner – Vibrer.** Those three words guide the Foundation's 3 members, 14 directors and 15 employees, speaking with one voice in the best interests of the music industry and the development of artists' careers.

Those three words are particularly relevant at a time when fundamental questions are raised about Musicaction's interventions, notably due to the progressive revenue loss expected in coming years. Concerted choices must be made regarding our orientations, always in the spirit of providing the best possible support, in line with the needs expressed by the music community and the market developments.

Today's market is certainly difficult, but after chaotic years we can glimpse better horizons and the emergence of new ways of doing things. Indeed, in terms of continuous improvement, the new fiscal year will feature several initiatives, in continuity with those taken this last year. On one hand, with regard to programs, the access afforded by the *New Musical Works* component will be questioned, the management program will be updated, and our interventions on behalf of emerging artists will be reviewed. On the other hand, with regard to the organization's governance, several newly formed Board of Directors committees will consolidate the scope of those programs to perpetuate the best practices, which our partners have applauded many times.

Lastly, I want to acknowledge the invaluable support of Canadian Heritage and private broadcasters; their reiterated support makes it possible to make timely interventions likely to generate positive results for all players in the industry. I also want to acknowledge the work of all the Directors, who serve as volunteers in the organization, and of the entire Foundation team, which never hesitates in its total commitment to carry out our mission.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND MUSICACTION STAFF

The Board of Directors is made up of 14 voting members. They consist of five broadcaster representatives appointed by CAB, four industry representatives appointed by ADISQ, two songwriter representatives appointed by SPACQ and three individuals with knowledge of the Canadian music industry, including one representative from the publishing industry. They also ensure that francophone minority communities in Canada are represented on the Board.

The Board of Directors approves the Foundation's strategic orientations and measures their progress, makes sure the programs are being managed effectively and efficiently, and is responsible for the organization's financial oversight. More specifically, with regard to the funding approval process, the Board's role is limited to accepting during its meetings a list of applications submitted by the administrative staff. As a result, Board members do not review individual applications, other than special situations occasionally brought to their attention. This minimizes the risk of potential conflicts of interest.

As for the administrative staff, it consists of 15 employees. It is entrusted with the management of day-to-day operations, under the supervision of the executive leadership. The staff reviews over 1,000 applications a year, and based on the type of funding requested, adheres to firmly entrenched procedures that include control mechanisms at every step of the process to ensure applications are thoroughly and fairly reviewed. The Foundation's employees and Board members are governed by a confidentiality agreement and conflict of interest guidelines.

ABORIGINAL COMMUNITIES

The music created by aboriginal communities is as diverse as their members. So we decided this year to emphasize that diversity, which for years has been a source of pride and inspiration for the Foundation.

All musical styles are concerned, as demonstrated by the reggae singer **Shauit**, from the Maliotenam reserve, a few kilometers from Sept-Îles on the North Shore, and by the rapper **Samian**, from *Pikogan*, an Algonquin community in Abitibi-Témiscamingue, and by **Elisapie Isaac**, a pop singer born in Nunavik and discovered in the duo **Taïma**.

The first rapper to sing in an aboriginal language, **Samian** was supported for his career's three albums: *Face à soi-même*, *Face à la musique* and, the latest one, *Enfant de la terre*. The reggaeman **Shauit**, whom we presented in a previous annual report, produced his first 4 songs, in Innu and in French, with the Foundation's aid. And this year, two talented young artists were guided, thanks to our support, by the organization **La Maison des cultures nomades**: **Matthew Vachon** alias Matiu, a competing artist in the 2016 edition of the Festival international de la chanson de Granby, and **Laura Niquay**, the first Atikamekw to have performed at the FrancoFolies de Montréal, in 2012. We'll surely hear about them again in coming years!

Disques 7^e Ciel, a Recognized Record Company based in Rouyn-Noranda, twice produced, under the 117 Records label, the collective project **Le Rythme**, a learning and development path where **eight young aborigines** develop their artistic talents together, an experience preparing them for the music industry's environment.

We can't talk about the aboriginal communities without mentioning one of their best and proudest ambassadors, the artist **Florent Vollant**. Born in Labrador, he first performed in the duo **Kashtin** before going solo. He recently released his fourth country-folk album, *Puamuna* (The Dream), recorded in his studio *Makusham* in Maliotenam with, among others, Philippe McKenzie, the first artist to record an album in the Innu language.

INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT: BECAUSE WE BELIEVE IN IT!

Since the establishment of the *International Market Development* program in 2010, our artists have performed in 43 events in 35 cities and 9 countries. Whether in events featuring francophone songs (19), emerging and alternative music (14), folk and traditional music (5), worldbeat music (3) or jazz (2), Canadian musical talent never ceases to impress.

Consolidation work began this year and will continue throughout the coming year with regard to our collective interventions abroad. In the last six years, we've explored a variety of places, events, partnership types and operationalizing methods. Several Canadian partners have expanded their network and refined the organization of their international initiatives, to the great benefit of our local artists.

Based on the convincing results of its first year of operation, the Foundation renewed in 2015-2016 the timely measure to provide mentoring and support to foreign industry professionals in major francophone events held in this country, so that they may view our artists in the best possible conditions, before their home audience. We think this is an important factor in developing our artists' careers in other markets, so this measure has become a permanent feature of our program.

Lastly, numerous artists have distinguished themselves internationally this year. For example, **Safia Nolin** (Bonsound) performed in a tour of 13 dates, opening 9 times for the French artist Lou Doillon; and **Medhi Cayenne** opened for Michel Fugain; and the **Benoît Paradis Trio** (Ambiances Ambiguës) performed in a marathon of concerts at the renowned Festival OFF in Avignon.

DOING THINGS DIFFERENTLY

The digital age's maturation is yielding more and more heterogeneous ways for music to be consumed. Indeed, almost 20 years after online downloading began and the CD's demise was predicted, the multiplicity of formats and supports, both digital and physical, is greatly modifying and influencing that diversity and making music more accessible than ever, everywhere, all the time. From pictures to streaming, to vinyl or even cassettes, those varied and multiple practices make it necessary to do things differently, across the board.

On one hand, technological developments offer more and more control, almost exclusively, to individuals in their choice of content. On the other hand, those same developments make it possible today to reach music consumers differently... to reach them where they are. This is the current challenge of this 2.0 culture, to the extent that it's distinct from the previous one. Fortunately, that distinction is gradually lessening, as the music industry's methods and habits better appropriate the digital ecosystem.

In that vein, changes were made in 2015-2016 to the interventions of the *Digital Market Development* collective program. A new component, *Skill Development* (Component 3), was created in support of initiatives to appropriate digital processes and develop good company practices. A first project was accepted during the fiscal year and, although that project is still underway, the results are promising so far for participating companies, given the new album launches planned for autumn 2016.

The two other components were reviewed, to maintain support for *Digital Market Development* (Component 1) and to foster the emergence of projects raising visibility and discoverability (Component 2 – *Large-Scale Promotion Project*).

Under Component 1, 10 projects were supported in 2015-2016, including one by a private company from the *Official Language Minority Communities*. A mobile application for smartphones and tablets, Atic, was created to raise the visibility of Acadian music artists, and is now available online. Under Component 2, a project was supported to optimize the labels' video channels and thus the artists' presence on the various platforms.

CANADA'S FRANCOPHONE COMMUNITIES: A REAL SOURCE OF INSPIRATION!

There's no denying the strength and vitality of the francophone communities' artists and artisans across the country. Year after year, the Musicaction Foundation witnesses, from front row seats, extraordinary artistic development and continuous professionalization.

For example, young talents such as **Simon Daniel** (New Brunswick), **CY** (Nova Scotia), **Céleste Lévis** (Ontario) and **Mario Lepage alias Pointex** (Saskatchewan), to name only a few, have performed alongside more-established artists such as **Isabelle Longnus** (British Columbia), **Danny Boudreau** (New Brunswick), **Vishtèn** (Prince Edward Island) and **Swing** (Ontario).

The *Music Showcase* program, exclusively intended for Canadian francophone communities' artists, has made possible **183 musical performances across Canada** and **78 internationally**. Whether in showcases or complete shows, **34 artists** have thus been able to demonstrate their talent and reach a diverse audience as well as music industry professionals.

Artistic talent is great, but initiatives to promote it are just as important! More than ever, we can state that Canadian francophonie is securing a place of choice in the musical landscape: in Canada, francophone community events and organizations as well as Quebec events are giving more and more prominence to artists from francophone minority communities; and abroad, those artists shine in the spotlight of partnership events (**BIS de Nantes**, **Folk Alliance**, **Festival Interceltique de Lorient**, **L'Estival**, **Voix de Fête**, **MaMA**, **Nuit Boréale**, **Festival Pause Guitare** and **Francofolies de Spa**).

ACCESS TO FUNDING

The foundation has instituted application and selection mechanisms aimed at ensuring that the projects we fund reflect Canadian music's wide diversity. Hence, funding is attributed in two ways. The first, via direct approval, allocates funding to Recognized Record Companies on an ongoing basis, bypassing the selection process — this system is predicated on the companies' proven track record guaranteeing their future performance. The second way funding is attributed is via a jury selection process including projects judged by an external evaluation committee accompanied by a grid and those measured by grid only.

This new policy is available on our website and we also added a form so that industry professionals and artists who wish to participate in this process can do so and feel they have a stake in the organization.

Whatever the approval method, a project's acceptance is still subject to the applicant's financial capacity to carry out future projects. The Board of Directors confirms the approval of all projects. A huge thank you to all who participated in a project artistic evaluation committee in 2015-2016.

Financial Contributions

Musicaction paid out \$8,290,332 in financial aid. The aid consisted of initial payments for projects accepted during the current year and final payments for projects accepted previously.

Other Expenditures

For the year ended March 31, 2016, Musicaction's administration costs and amortization of capital and intangible assets amounted to 11.6% of total revenues, compared to 10.7% in 2014-2015.

ALBUM PRODUCTION

122 artists or groups – \$1,756,869

This program is intended for album and music DVD production. Unless from a Recognized Record Company, album projects are evaluated based on their artistic merit by an independent jury. Projects are ineligible for evaluation by jury if they pertain to artists who received Musicaction funding for four album projects (for francophone vocal music) and seven album projects for other music genres, or artists having sold over 150,000 copies during the course of their career.

To be eligible, applicants must have a distribution deal with a physical or digital distributor recognized by Musicaction, and the album must comply with Canadian and French-language content requirements. For albums subject to jury evaluation, Musicaction funding can reach \$30,000 for francophone vocal music and worldbeat projects, and \$20,000 for other music genres. Funding can be as high as \$50,000 for albums produced by a Recognized Record Company.

Song Production: 20 artists or groups – \$96,958

Song Promotion: 20 artists or groups – \$130,826

This program is intended for Recognized Record Companies and applicants who have a distribution contract with a recognized physical or digital distributor or who are working with a record label that has such a contract. The recording must comply with Canadian and French-language content requirements. Funding for production purposes is capped at \$12,000, i.e. \$3,000 per song for a maximum of 4 songs, and at \$10,000 for promotion purposes. Projects subject to jury consideration under this program are evaluated at 40% for artistic merit and at 60% according to the evaluation chart.

EMERGING ARTIST SUPPORT PROGRAM

Component 1 – Song Production and Promotion: 8 artists or groups – \$77,900

Component 2 – Artist Integration: 13 organizations – \$119,608

The **first component** of the *Emerging Artists Support program*, **Song Production and Promotion**, is intended for emerging artists. Funding can be up to \$12,000, i.e. \$5,000 for production purposes for four required songs and \$7,000 for promotion purposes. Three of the four songs must be works that have never been commercially released. The rollout of promotional activities is also required, with a minimum investment of \$1,000 earmarked for promotion, advertising or live show purposes. Herein, projects are evaluated at 60% for artistic merit and 40% according to the evaluation chart.

The **second component**, which focuses on **Artist Integration**, enables organizations that work with emerging artists to apply for funding for projects targeting the professional development and integration of one or several young artists. The funding per project may reach \$5,000 for one artist, and \$10,000 for two or more artists. Musicaction's contribution equals 75% of the project's eligible costs. A portion of the funding is reserved for projects by emerging artists from francophone communities living in a minority situation.

To foster the development of an original music repertoire and collaboration between songwriters and composers, funding is automatically granted to Canadian songwriters and composers who took part in an album or a song whose production was funded by Musicaction. It has to be for a work of at least 60 seconds that is being reproduced for the first time on a commercial platform. Funding is limited to the Canadian portion of the work.

The remaining applications are evaluated based on a chart that takes into account the project's professional entourage, marketing plan and project performance (sales, airplay and shows).

The activities eligible for consideration under this program are promotion, image production and live performances. Funding per project cannot exceed \$60,000, from which a maximum of \$20,000 can be earmarked for image production (maximum \$15,000 for a videoclip) and \$25,000 for stage activities, including \$10,000 specifically allocated for a domestic tour.

INTERNATIONAL MARKETING

59 artists or groups – \$785,740

This three-component program is intended for international initiatives ultimately focused on distributing and marketing an album on a territory other than Canada. All applications, including those of Recognized Record Companies, are subject to an evaluation chart. With few exceptions, the priority markets for francophone vocal music are those of European francophonie. As for other territories or musical categories, on a case-by-case basis, it may be required to demonstrate whether career development is possible on the target territory, taking into account the musical category associated with the project and the existence of a real industrial structure in the target market.

Component 1, Prospecting a Target Market, makes it possible for artists to travel to a specific territory to perform in a live show or a music showcase attended by industry professionals, for the purpose of finding a team that will help them develop said territory. Funding for this component is capped at \$25,000 per project and limited to \$7,500 per trip for a single showcase and to \$10,000 if other performances take place on the territory. A project to promote an artist and surround him or her with a professional team in the target market is also eligible under this component.

Component 2, Developing a Career in a Target Market, is aimed at artists who minimally have a contract with a foreign party in the market targeted by the project. Promotional and stage activities are eligible provided the album has adequate physical or digital distribution on the territory in question. Generally, funding for this component is capped at \$50,000, from which we deduct any sums granted under Component 1. It should be noted that the program's existing exception for projects regarding an artist's participation in an official showcase within a partnership event abroad, funded *International Market Development*, is broadened in 2015-2016 to include any eligible applicant, even if the artist is associated with a MEC company and however extensive that association. MEC beneficiary companies remain ineligible for any funding for *New Musical Works* under Canadian Heritage rules. Moreover, apart from that exception, program eligibility for projects involving artists associated with MEC companies applies, on an exploratory basis for 2015-2016, solely to the territory covered by the companies' exploitation rights to the sound recording in support of the project.

Lastly, **Component 3, Marketing Catalogs from Specialized Record Labels**, focuses on promoting albums whose initial release date does not exceed 18 months prior to the submission of the application.

Record producers and labels, managers, publishers, recognized distributors, music associations and companies funded under the **Collective Initiatives program** are eligible for this program.

ARTIST MANAGEMENT

26 companies – \$402,650

This program is intended for managers involved in the career advancement and professional development of emerging artists. Subject to a business plan and a career development plan (for each of the artists the application is intended for), projects are evaluated on the basis of an evaluation chart. Access to funding is predicated on five criteria, i.e. minimum two years in business, financial statements supported by at least a foreword, a number of artists deemed eligible including one emerging artist, and minimum sales figures. A second evaluative phase follows, during which only projects capable of demonstrating a superior return abetted by relevant and coherent strategies are approved. Funding for record labels can reach up to \$15,000 for two or more artists, and \$10,000 for one artist. Independent producers may receive up to \$20,000 for two or more artists, and \$15,000 for one artist.

ACCESS TO THE QUÉBEC SCENE

25 projects – \$593,500

This program's primary purpose is to stimulate the inclusion of emerging artists who perform in French in major Québec events, as a means of fostering their career development. Specialty music events that can offer significant exposure to Canadian artists who are involved in the music field being targeted are also eligible.

The **first component, French-Language Music Events**, can allocate up to \$85,000 per event. The main requirement is that in the most recent edition of the event and the upcoming edition, at least eight Canadian emerging artists will have been featured whose last French-language album (or 4-track digital release) was funded by Musicaction or a Québec organization having benefited from MEC funding. Funding is granted based on figures from the event's most recent editions in comparison to the combined figures from all the events eligible for funding (audience, industry professionals guests, etc.), and supplementary funding is allocated based on five other criteria, including the prevalence of Canadian artists performing in French, the direct benefits for the artists, and equitable distribution between the major urban centres and outlying regions. .

The **second component, Specialty Music Events**, can allocate up to \$25,000 per event. The main requirement is that in the most recent edition of the event and the upcoming edition, at least eight Canadian artists will have performed for a set period of time based on the type of event. As with the first component, funding is granted based on figures from the event's previous edition, and supplementary funding is allocated based on five other criteria, including equitable distribution among the various specialty music genres being funded and the unifying pull of the event (supported by a maximum number of individuals and organizations involved in that specialty music genre).

Equitable distribution among the three main Canadian regions and the provinces continues to be a key consideration as to how funding is allocated.

CANADA'S FRANCOPHONE COMMUNITIES MUSIC SHOWCASE

34 artists, 6 events from Canadian francophone communities, 5 Quebecor events and 7 national tours led by the presenter's network – \$744,280

The main objective of this program is to stimulate the booking of francophone artists living in minority communities in events of a certain magnitude, so as to foster the development of their professional careers. The program also increases access by Canadian francophone minority communities to musical offerings in their own language.

The program spans these five components:

Component 1 – National Showcase Funding for Artists: Intended to support artists from Canada's francophone communities who are selected to perform an official unpaid showcase before industry professionals. The maximum aid is \$4,500 per trip and covers the performance fees, travel and accommodation expenses of up to five persons, as well as promotional expenses.

Component 2 – National Tours: Intended to facilitate access to live show activities for francophone and anglophone audiences. Its purpose is to develop artists professionally and provide them with better exposure via tours in Canada. Each tour requires two applications: one from the network and the other from the artist or his or her agent. Stage aid is granted to the show's producer, and aid is also granted to the presenters and the network. Regarding audience development, additional aid of up to \$7,500 is also granted to francophone networks to stimulate the public by a specific promotion on digital platforms (formerly Component 6).

Component 3 – International Showcases and Tours: Intended to stimulate the inclusion of Canadian francophone artists in the lineup of performers for events abroad so they can enjoy significantly broader exposure. Maximum aid is \$8,000 per trip for a showcase and \$17,500 per tour, covering performance fees, travel and accommodation expenses for up to five persons, as well as promotional expenses.

Component 4 – French-Language Music Events in Canadian Francophone Communities: Intended to support Canadian events held in provinces or territories outside Québec that attract a sizeable number of industry professionals and give artists from francophone communities measurable exposure.

Component 5 – Funding for Promoting and Hosting Artists for French-Language Music Events in Québec: Intended to promote and stimulate the inclusion of artists from francophone communities in major French-language music events, through aid of up to \$1,000 per artist for professional fees and of up to \$7,500 for a specific promotional activity.

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INTERNATIONAL MARKET DEVELOPMENT

34 projects – \$466,500

The purpose of the **International Market Development** program is to help Canadian artists develop their careers abroad. The **first component** revolves around the presentation and promotion of international showcases, which generally must be held outside Canada. Applicants must be recognized for having a certain expertise in putting together artist showcases, and priority is given to projects with established ties to a foreign partner. Funding per project under the first component is capped at \$40,000. The **second component** focuses on collective promotional initiatives whose primary objective is to spotlight the works of Canadian artists on foreign soil with a view to furthering their careers. Funding for this component can generally reach \$20,000 per project.

We introduced a timely measure in 2014-2015. Comprising two components, it is designed to bring industry professionals from abroad to Canada for eligible francophone music events, so they may see Canadian artists performing under the best possible conditions and in front of their fans. The **Music Industry Professionals Component** is meant to incentivize and extend the practice of inviting foreign industry professionals to events. As for the **Mentoring and Support Component**, it is intended to add or improve tools or activities aimed at maximizing the presence of foreign industry professionals, in order to yield even more benefits and opportunities for Canadian artists. Funding is capped at \$7,000 per event.

DIGITAL MARKET DEVELOPMENT

8 projects – \$402,000

By its three components, the program supports collective initiatives to optimize the offering and promotion of Canadian musical content, mainly francophone, in Canadian and foreign digital markets. Applications are evaluated according to a chart taking into account the project's collective scope, partnership quality, description quality, potential return and budgetary realism.

Component 1 – Digital Market Development aims at creating or updating a platform, website, application, tool or any other interactive project legally offering Canadian music content online. The aid can cover eligible costs for designing, developing and promoting this type of initiative or a combination of those phases, depending on the project, and may total up to \$75,000 annually, over two years, as well as covering 50% of eligible expenses.

Component 2 – Large-Scale Promotion Project aims at large-scale collective promotional activities or initiatives that will have a major impact on the development, visibility, accessibility or positioning of Canadian francophone music in digital markets. This component applies solely to new promotional activities or initiatives, and may cover development costs, depending on the project. Component 2 is intended for companies and organizations that by their very nature have a major collective scope. The aid covers 75% of eligible expenses and the maximum per project is \$100,000, with few exceptions.

Component 3 – Skill Development Project aims at supporting Canadian entrepreneurs in the acquisition of skills and know-how to succeed in digital markets. More specifically, it fosters original initiatives for participating companies to better appropriate the digital ecosystem, and it helps develop effective practices and processes for their activities in those markets. The participation of at least two companies is necessary. The aid covers 75% of eligible expenses, up to \$50,000 per project.

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INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Directors of

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of **La Fondation Musicaction**, which comprise the balance sheet as at March 31, 2016, and the statements of earnings, changes in net assets and cash flows for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's responsibility for the financial statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. 1. STATUTES AND PURPOSE OF THE ORGANIZATION

La Fondation Musicaction was incorporated on September 9, 1985, as a non-profit organization without share capital, pursuant to Part II of the Canada Business Corporations Act. In December 2013, La Fondation Musicaction extended these statutes under section 211 of the *Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act*.

La Fondation Musicaction is a non-profit organization whose objective is to assist in the promotion, management, production, and marketing of sound recordings and video-clips in Canada or in foreign markets. For this purpose, La Fondation Musicaction offers financial contribution programs that are available to artists, record companies, producers, publishers, managers, distributors, and to Canadian authors and composers, as well as to associations.

Pursuant to the *Income Tax Act* (Canada) and the *Taxation Act* (Quebec), La Fondation Musicaction is classified as a non-profit organization, and therefore, is not subject to income taxes.

2. FUNDING OF THE ORGANIZATION

On April 16, 2015, two contribution agreements were signed between the Department of Canadian Heritage and La Fondation Musicaction for the administration of the Canada Music Fund and, more specifically, for two programs entitled New Musical Works and Collective Initiatives. These agreements will provide for the following annual contributions of \$4,178,790 for each of the years ended March 31, 2016 to 2020 and the following annual contributions for the Collective Initiatives program of \$1,669,743 for each of the years ended March 31, 2016 to 2020. The contributions received during the year amounted to \$4,178,790 (\$4,178,790 in 2015) for the New Musical Works Program and \$1,699,743 (\$1,699,743 in 2015) for the Collective Initiatives program. Under these agreements, a maximum of 13.5% of the contributions may be allocated to administrative and communication expenses, audit fees and assessment expenses incurred by La Fondation Musicaction.

3. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements were prepared in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations (ASNPO) and include the following significant accounting policies.

Use of estimates

The preparation of these financial statements, in accordance with ASNPO, requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amount of assets and liabilities, the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amount of revenues and expenses during the current period. The most subjective estimates relate to the Impairment of long-lived assets and life span of capital assets and intangible assets.

3. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

Revenue recognition

La Fondation Musicaction uses the deferral method of accounting for contributions. Contributions originating from the Canada Music Fund are accounted for based on financial contributions granted, while contributions from radio broadcasters are accounted for using the cash basis of accounting, with the exception of products for which a firm commitment has been given.

Contributions from radio broadcasters are an express underlying condition for obtaining and renewing their broadcast licenses with the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC).

In addition, in the case of transactions involving the acquisition of radio broadcasting companies, the CRTC specifically demands that the acquiring party make contributions to agencies that are dedicated to the development of Canadian talent. La Fondation Musicaction benefits from a portion of these contributions, which have been accounted for as transfers of ownership.

Financial instruments

Measurement of financial instruments

La Fondation Musicaction initially measures its financial assets and liabilities at fair value. They are subsequently measured at amortized cost. Changes in fair value are recognized in the statement of earnings.

Financial contributions

All of the programs offered by La Fondation Musicaction are in the form of financial contributions and are accounted for as expenses when they have been fully allocated.

Capital assets

Capital assets are recorded at historical cost. Amortization is calculated using the straight-line method based on the following periods:

Condominium	25 years
Furniture and office equipment	7 years
Computer equipment	4 years
Telephone equipment	10 years

Intangible assets

Intangible assets are recorded at historical cost. Amortization is calculated using the straight-line method over a four-year period.

3. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

Impairment of long-lived assets

A long-lived asset is tested for impairment whenever events or changes in circumstances indicate that its carrying amount may not be recoverable. An impairment loss is recognized when the carrying amount of the asset exceeds the sum of the undiscounted cash flows resulting from its use and eventual disposition. The impairment loss is measured at the amount by which the carrying amount of the long-lived asset exceeds its fair value.

Contributed services

Members of La Fondation Musicaction's Board of Directors attend Board meetings without compensation. The value of the time donated by these directors is not recorded in the financial statements, because it would be difficult to measure its fair value.

Cash and cash equivalents

For cash flow purposes, La Fondation Musicaction policy is to present cash and term deposits for which the maturity date does not exceed three months from the date of acquisition.

4. CAPITAL DISCLOSURES

With respect to its capital management, La Fondation Musicaction's objective is to preserve its ability to pursue its operations in order to continue to comply with its purpose as described in Note 1, taking into account its financial resources which allow it to meet its remaining commitments and to pay financial contributions to newly submitted projects.

Except for the fact that a maximum of 13.5% of the contributions may be allocated to administrative, communication, audit and assessment expenses, under external rules, La Fondation Musicaction, is not subject to capital requirements.

5. INTERNALLY RESTRICTED NET ASSETS

The Board of Directors allocated net assets in the amount of \$4,377,567 (\$4,314,133 in 2015) in order to cover the payment of commitments related to financial contributions for which La Fondation Musicaction was committed as at March 31, 2016, and to provide for administrative expenses related to monitoring and settling these commitments estimated at a maximum of 13.5%.

Financial contributions

As at March 31, 2016, La Fondation Musicaction is contractually committed to advance funds totalling \$3,786,595 (\$3,731,725 in 2015). Of this amount, a portion of \$181,849 (\$288,216 in 2015) represents commitments to related enterprises. In order to realize its commitments, La Fondation Musicaction will incur administrative expenses of a maximum of 13.5%.

13. FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS

Liquidity risk

As at March 31, 2016, La Fondation Musicaction recorded contributions receivable from Patrimoine Canada. Those contributions were received shortly after year-end. During the year, all the contributions provided for in the agreements with Patrimoine Canada were received.

However, the agreements stipulate that all payments made under those agreements are subject to the credit grants by the Canadian Parliament and the continuance of the actual budget and the budget estimates for the programs.

Thus, the Federal government can, at its discretion, decrease the financing and cancel those agreements by sending a written 90-day prior notice to La Fondation Musicaction. Should the financing be terminated, La Fondation Musicaction would be reimbursed for all the costs incurred up to the date the notice comes into effect, subject to the agreements' terms and conditions. If this event occurs, La Fondation Musicaction could be exposed to the mentioned risks.

Interest rate risk

La Fondation Musicaction is exposed to interest rate risk regarding its financial instruments with fixed interest rates. Financial instruments with fixed interest rates expose La Fondation Musicaction to a fair value risk. As at March 31, 2016, La Fondation Musicaction holds term deposits with short and long-term maturities, as well as capital shares with long-term maturities.

14. PENSION PLAN

La Fondation Musicaction has a defined contribution pension plan providing pension benefits to its employees with at least three months of service. Contributions to the pension plan represent 7% of the basic salary and are subject to the employee's voluntary contribution of 3.5%. The pension plan costs of \$49,340 (\$49,162 in 2015) are included in salary expenses in the statement of earnings.
